Position: BOARD OF EVANGELISM

Accountable to: VOTERS ASSEMBLY

PURPOSE: To oversee and give direction to the congregation's evangelism and outreach activities.

- The Board shall meet monthly, or more often as needed.
- The Board shall consist of a minimum of three persons.
- Each member shall serve for a period of three years.
- Each member shall attend and participate in regular meetings of the Board.
- A designated member of the Board shall give a written or verbal report to the Church Council.

## The work of evangelism should:

- 1. Strive to generate in the entire congregation a Christian concern regarding lost souls and the Christian's responsibility as witness-bearer.
- 2. Encourage members of the congregation to witness to one another as well as to the unsaved.
- 3. Foster a climate of evangelism by cooperating with the pastor in arranging evangelism emphasis worship services and special programs.
- 4. Assist in the selection of mission projects to present to church council for approval.
- 5. Prepare publicity concerning projects for monthly newsletter, Sunday worship folder, etc., by deadline.
- 6. Prepare prayers and/or prayer suggestions for projects.
- 7. Be a catalyst to encourage volunteerism for missions.
